

MGA E-MAIL POLICY

As of March 1st, 2010, there are 356 Men's Golf Association members. The MGA sends e-mail to all members with e-mail addresses on record. Some either do not currently use e-mail or their MGA e-mail access is still pending. Any member who is not able to receive the e-mails should contact the VP-Communications for assistance in getting set up.

Members can respond to the various messages sent to them or they can initiate an E-mail to the MGA by emailing: mga@fcmgagolf.org, thus, encouraging two- way communication between the members and the organization.

The MGA policy that governs its e-mail is:

The MGA's main focus is on MGA activities and news about individual MGA members. Usually, but not always, the Tournament Director or event chairman drafts a narrative for the Vice President - Communications who then edits the material and sends it out.

Information of interest to MGA members on golfing operations and events involving golf and social programs at Ford's Colony Country Club are also provided at the discretion of the MGA Vice President - Communications. Information on personnel changes in the Pro Shop or the management of the Country Club fall into this category. It is not the intent of the MGA to use its e-mail system as a conduit for information on general activities and policies of The Country Club Member's Association or Ford's Colony Country Club.

The MGA feels strongly that the membership has an obligation to help in maintaining the golf courses and in maintaining an efficient pace of play. Periodic notices from the MGA on these topics will be sent to the membership. Also, communication from the Greens Committee and the Golf/HRT Committee of The Country Club Member's Association will be passed on to the membership.

Information on activities related to golf within Ford's Colony or the Williamsburg area may be publicized if requested by the participating MGA members and approved by the MGA Vice President - Communications.

Notice of a serious illness or death of a member may be sent to the membership, provided a member of the family gives approval.
