

GOLFER OF THE YEAR

Each year the MGA recognizes the golfers who have achieved success during the golfing season in all aspects of MGA golf tournament activities. Points are awarded for winning performances during the period April 1st through Monthly Stroke Play on Wednesday in October in the categories listed below:

1. The Four Major Tournaments:

**Olde Towne Medical Center Tournament
The Memorial Match Play Championship
The MGA Championship
The Shark Shootout**

Points are awarded as follows:

8 points for flight and overall winner
4 points for flight runners-up

2. The Monthly Stroke Tournaments*

Points are awarded as follows:

6 points for overall low gross, low net winners, and flight winners.
3 points for low net runners-up

3. Weekly Wednesday Tournaments*

Points are awarded as follows:

2 points for flight winners
1 point for runners-up

4. Wednesday Interclub (Home or Away)

1 point for each MGA competitor

The MGA golfer accumulating the most points from the above activities will be designated “Outstanding Golfer of the Year” and will receive a plaque at year end. Those placing in the top 20 (plus ties) will be invited to play in the prestigious “President’s Cup” match at the end of the year. During the season standings of the leaders will be posted monthly on the MGA’s web site and on the Bulletin Board.

** Once a month beginning in April and ending in October, the Weekly Wednesday Shot Gun Tournament becomes stroke play with individual members competing against each other in pre-selected flights. The format for all other Weekly Wednesday Tournaments is foursomes competing against other foursomes in pre-arranged flights.*
